
OMEGA timepieces are designed to accompany you for a lifetime if they receive the best care. The service frequency depends on the use and the environment in which they are worn. We recommend having a complete service performed every 5 to 8 years at an OMEGA authorised service centre.

COMPLETE SERVICE

The complete service restores the functional and aesthetic aspect. The watch is completely dismantled and overhauled.

STEPS OF THE COMPLETE SERVICE

- 1. Disassembling the case and the movement
- 2. Cleaning the movement
- 3. Replacing worn components of the movement
- 4. Reassembling and lubricating the movement
- 5. Adjusting the movement and controlling its parameters
- 6. Cleaning and polishing the case and bracelet
- Reassembling the case and replacing the components listed in the service kit (see page 7)
- 8. Complete quality control
- N.B. Polishing helps to refresh the appearance of the watch and to reduce the visible signs of wear and tear. The case and bracelet are polished free of charge as part of a complete service. If you wish to maintain the current aesthetic appearance of your watch, you must specifically request that it should not be polished.


Routine servicing including the replacement of seals and gaskets is necessary to ensure the long-term water resistance of your timepiece. We therefore recommend an annual water resistance check at an OMEGA authorised service centre.

WATER RESISTANCE SERVICE

This service guarantees that the watch is water resistant according to the model's specifications.

STEPS OF THE WATER RESISTANCE SERVICE

- 1. Disassembling the case
- 2. Cleaning the case and bracelet
- 3. Reassembling the case and replacing the components listed in the service kit (see page 7)
- 4. Replacing the battery (for electronic calibres)
- 5. Tuning the precision
- 6. Complete quality control

Dial restoration	1,400.—	The dial restoration involves opening and dismantling the watch. Therefore, at least a water resistance service is required and will be charged additionally.
Case polishing (polish / satin finish)	120.—	The case polishing involves opening and dismantling the watch. Therefore, a water resistance service is required and will be charged additionally.
Bracelet polishing (polish / satin finish)	150.—	It is recommended to have the case and bracelet polished at the same time to prevent aesthetical discrepancies. NB: Ceramic and plated metal watches cannot be polished.




